

### **Opening commentary of the Mass**

*Dear brothers and sisters, you are welcome to this celebration. Today is the feast of our founder Blessed Joseph Allamano in which our Consolata Family in the Americas begins the Vocational Biennium. First of all, we want to thank God for the gift of vocation that Consolata missionaries have received in the spirit of the founder and the company of the Virgin Mother Consolata, "Woman of new wine." **Commentary to Scripture Readings**

*The Word of God directs and feeds the proclamation of the Gospel to all peoples of the world. In the first reading, St. Paul exhorts us to renew the gift of God in everyone. We should cherish our vocation; we cannot dishonor the charism of our sublime and holy vocation. This reading also reminds us of the imperative of Blessed Joseph Allamano: Saints first, then missionaries.*

*In the Gospel, Jesus proclaims his messianic project, emphasizing his preference for the poor and oppressed. Encouraged by the Spirit, let's take consolation to the people on this mission he fulfilled and that all of us, missionary disciples, must undertake.*

**FIRST READING (2 Tim 1: 1-3. 6-12)**

**A Reading from the Second Letter of St. Paul to Timothy**

Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, in keeping with the promise of life that is in Christ Jesus; to Timothy, my dear son: Grace, mercy and peace from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord.

I thank God, whom I serve, as my ancestors did, with a clear conscience, as night and day I constantly remember you in my prayers. For this reason I remind you to rekindle the gift of God, which is in you through the laying on of my hands. For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline.

So do not be ashamed of the testimony about our Lord or of me his prisoner. Rather, join with me in suffering for the Gospel, by the power of God. He has saved us and called us to a holy life—not because of anything we have done but because of his own purpose and grace. This grace was given to us in Christ Jesus before the beginning of time, but it has now been revealed through the appearing of our Savior, Christ Jesus, who has destroyed death and has brought life and immortality to light through the Gospel. And of this Gospel I was appointed a herald and an apostle and a teacher.

That is why I am suffering as I am. Yet this is no cause for shame, because I know whom I have believed, and am convinced that he is able to guard what I have entrusted to him until that day.

*"The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim the release to the captives, and recovery of sight to the blind, to set free those who are oppressed, to proclaim the Favorable year of the Lord."*

Then he closed the book, gave it back to the attendant and sat down; the eyes of all in the synagogue were fixed on him. He began to say to them, "Today this Scripture has been fulfilled in your hearing."
